Course Description

The recent pandemic has dramatically increased telehealth services for Physical Therapy. Vestibular disorders present a unique challenge for safe and effective virtual interventions and rehabilitation. This presentation will provide an overview of pathophysiology of common vestibular disorders and use case studies to highlight safe and appropriate patient selection for interventions via telehealth. Standard outcome measures and fall risk screenings most well suited for telehealth will be reviewed, as well as novel and creative solutions to providing robust and evidence based interventions via telehealth.

Objectives

1. Review pathophysiology of common vestibular disorders with emphasize on BPPV and Vestibular Neuritis.
2. Demonstrate importance of safety, screenings, precautions and contraindications for a Telehealth Vestibular Evaluation.
3. Have access to virtual resources for robust and clear patient education regarding vestibular disorders.
4. Demonstrate creative options for vestibular rehabilitation interventions via telehealth.

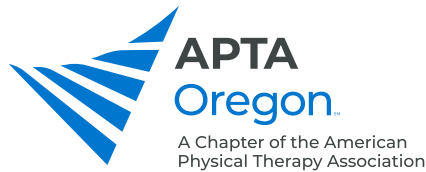
Speaker
